Site address Provide sufficient detail to accurately locate the site	
Processes / activities Describe the main activities that occur or it is expected will occur at the place. For each Schedule 1 substance, describe its particular involvement in an activity (e.g. use or production – static storage, blending, synthesis, formulation, processing, heating, packaging, transport operations, process flow diagram or dangerous goods pipelines).	
Risk assessment and emergency plan In relation to Schedule 1 substances, describe all scenarios and potential consequences where people (both on and off site), property or the environment can be impacted. Include the maximum credible distance each scenario can cause serious harm.	
Location map Provide a scaled location map covering at least a 1km radius from the place. Identify the local government zoning in the surrounding area with particular attention to sensitive land use, residential and activities that may impact on the place. Show the potential impact zones of the major incidents on the surrounding area from Schedule 1 substances Provide sufficient details of the natural and built environment to enable assessment of the possible impact of a major incident.
