

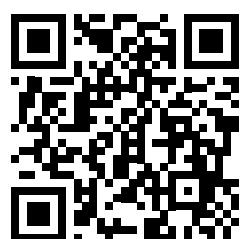
Do you carry dangerous goods in your van?

Fatalities and severe injuries have occurred when work vehicles exploded after gas from oxy-acetylene equipment or LP gas cylinders leaked into the vehicle. It was then ignited by a spark from a remote locking key, interior light or by a lit cigarette.

Safety tips for transporting gas cylinders in enclosed trade vans

- Ensure cylinders have a current legible test mark.
- Close cylinder valves and use safety caps. Empty all gas hoses.
- Ensure vehicle windows are wound down for cross-flow ventilation.
- Securely restrain cylinders in an upright position on the vehicle floor.
- Do not smoke or vape in or near the vehicle.
- Remove cylinders from the vehicle before using them.
- Carry a fire extinguisher within easy access.
