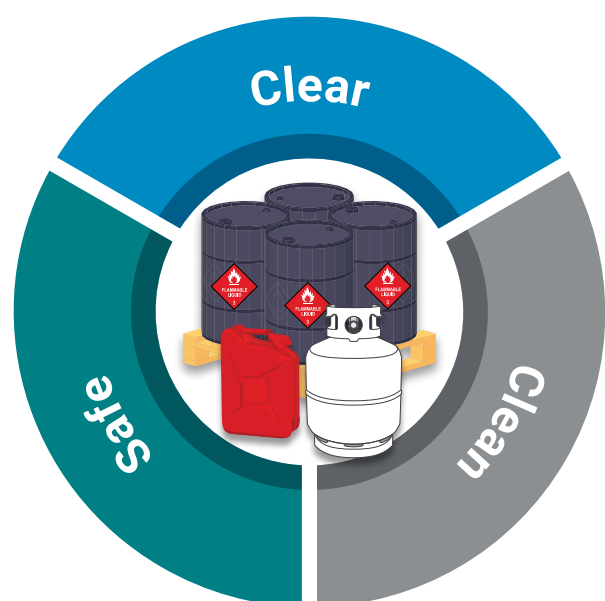


Looking after dangerous goods in your community



- ✓ **Clear** – Remove fuel for fires: no wood, pallets or bush for at least 3 metres
- ✓ **Clean** – Fix leaks and clean-up spills
- ✓ **Safe** – Have fire extinguishers nearby

Avoid possible ignition sources

No smoking, vaping, mobile phones, welding or grinding



What can you do if there is a chemical fire, spill or leak?

If it is safe and easy



Put out small fires



Try and stop small spills and leaks (e.g. spill kit)



Tell your community CEO

If it is not safe or easy

Tell the fire brigade or your community CEO



Stay away from the fire or spill



Stay safe

Keep out of smoke coming from burning chemicals



Avoid spilled or leaking chemicals



Cleaning up spills

Use a spill kit:

- clean sand or dirt to absorb the spill
- a broom or shovel to collect the contaminated sand or dirt
- clean, empty containers (with a lid) to put the sand or dirt into.
