# Rigging operations

### Basic rigging (RB)

The scope of work for basic rigging includes:

- dogging work
- installation and removal of the following:
  - o structural steel erection
  - o hoists and mast climbing work platforms
  - o pre-cast concrete members of a structure
  - o safety nets and static lines
  - o perimeter safety screens and shutters
  - o cantilevered crane loading platforms
  - o use of mechanical lifting means e.g. winch.

A basic rigger uses their dogging skills to sling and direct loads which they may then install or remove into or from a structure. This work often requires a high level of precision. Setting up and using mechanical lifting requires the specialised knowledge of a basic rigger.

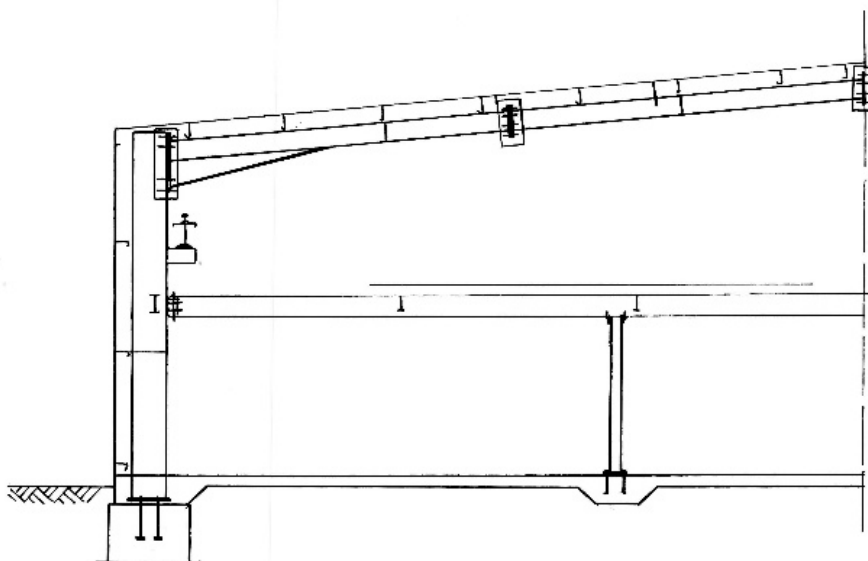


Figure Steel erection
