

High risk work licence classes

Rigging operations

Intermediate rigging (RI)

The scope of work for an immediate rigging licence includes:

- rigging work in the class dogging and basic rigging
- hoist with jibs and self-climbing hoists
- cranes, conveyors, dredges and excavators
- installing tilt slabs
- demolition of structures or plant
- dual lifts.

An intermediate rigger conducts complex, high risk rigging work, they may erect cranes, oversee complex lifts such as heavy machinery lifts or dual/multi crane or crane/winch lifts.

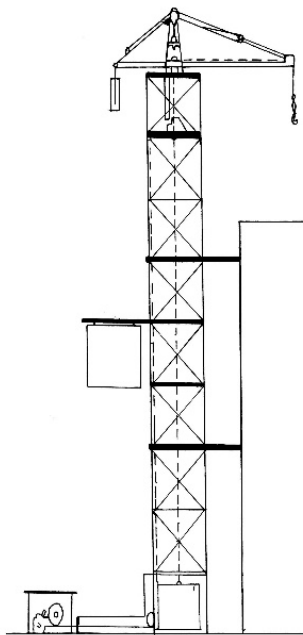


Figure 1 Typical hoist with jib

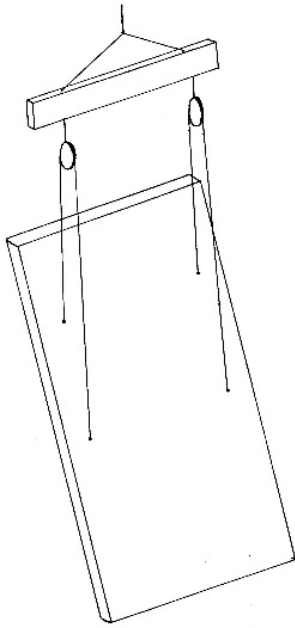


Figure 2 Tilt slab with loading equaliser gear
