Forklift

Order picking forklift truck (LO)

This licence authorises the operation of order picking forklift trucks.

An order picking forklift truck is a specialised type of forklift designed to lift the operator so they can pick items directly from storage shelves. It is fitted with a platform that raises both the operator and the load, allowing safe and efficient access to goods at height. Order picking forklifts are designed for use in narrow aisles, are often electric powered, and are typically used indoors in warehouses and distribution centres where individual items or cartons are selected rather than full pallets.

An order-picking forklift truck is used for:

- picking individual items or cartons from storage racks
- working in warehouses and distribution centres.
- fulfilling orders rather than moving full pallets.

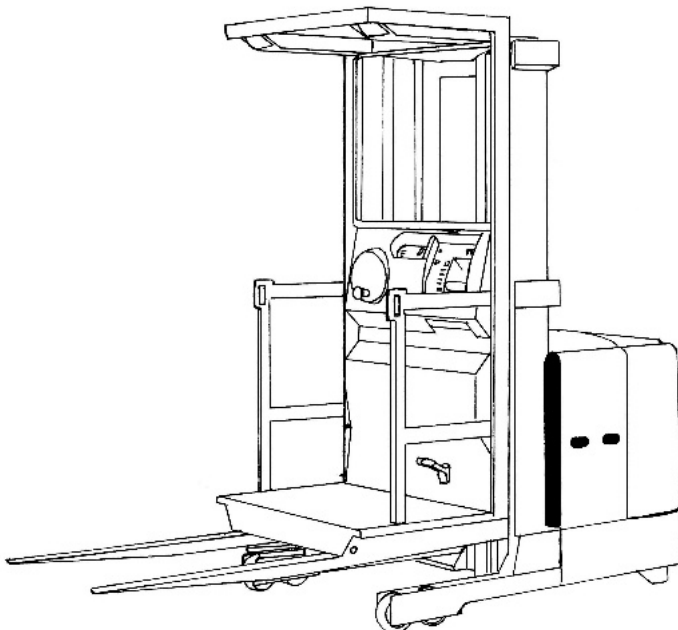


Figure Order picking forklift truck
