Hoists

Personnel and materials hoist (HP)

This licence authorises the operation of a personnel and materials hoist.

Holding a personnel and materials hoist licence also satisfies the licencing requirements for operating a materials hoist.

A personnel and materials hoist is a mechanical lifting device used to safely lift both people and materials up and down a building or structure. It is fixed to a building, scaffold, or other structure and uses a cage or enclosed platform to transport workers, tools, equipment, and building materials vertically. The hoist operates using electric or mechanical power and is designed with safety controls specifically suited for carrying people, providing safe and efficient access to different levels on construction sites.

A personnel and materials hoist is used for:

- lifting workers to different levels of a building
- lifting tools, equipment, and building materials
- providing safe access to higher work areas on construction sites.

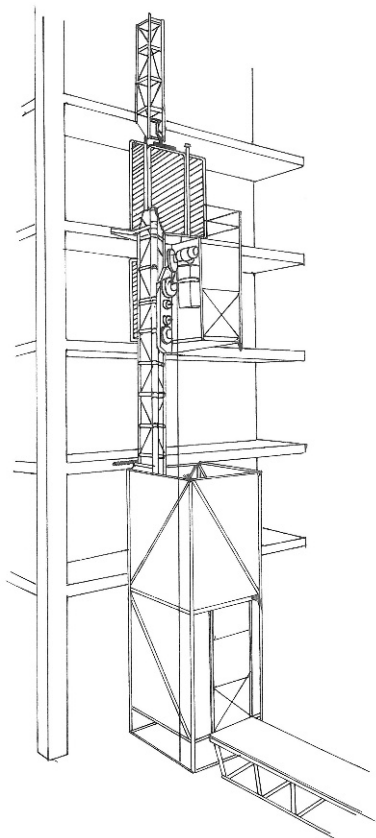


Figure Materials or personnel hoist
