Cranes

Portal boom crane (CP)

This licence authorises the operation of all portal boom cranes.

A portable boom crane is a type of crane that uses a long arm, known as a boom, to lift and move loads up, down, and across an area. The boom can be raised and lowered, and in some cases rotated, allowing loads to be positioned accurately. Boom cranes may be fixed in one location or mounted on a vehicle, making them versatile for a range of construction, loading, and maintenance tasks where materials need to be lifted and moved efficiently.

A portal boom crane used for:

- lifting materials to higher levels
- moving loads out and away from the crane base
- working on construction, loading, or maintenance jobs.

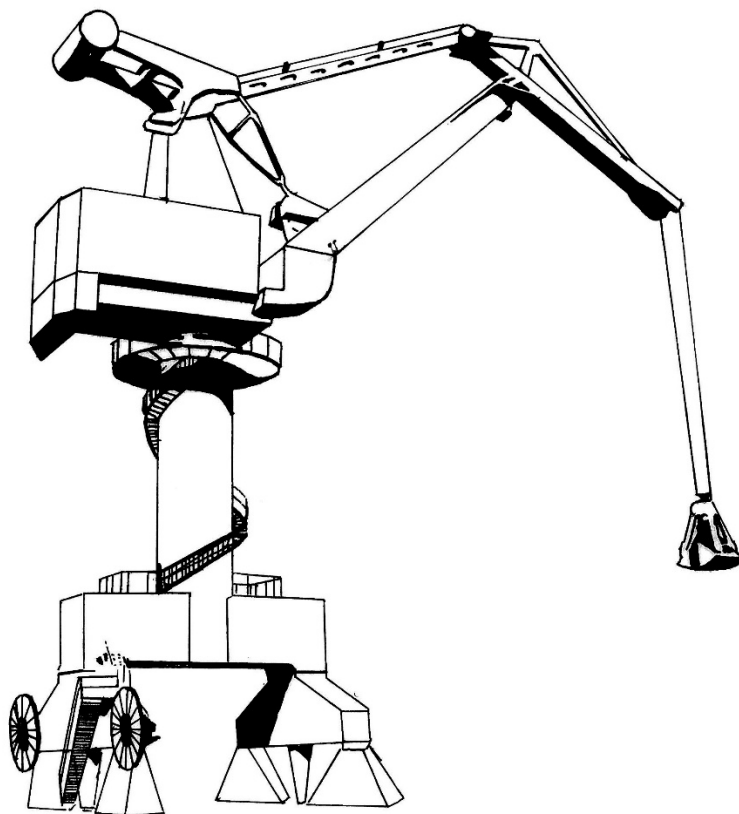


Figure Portal boom crane
